I. Administration

- A. The SCC President will appoint a Points Chair. The Points Chair shall:
 - Collect points information from appropriate Club Officers and Committee Chairs in accordance with the Santa Clara Corvettes Year-End Point Structure.
 - 2. Maintain Competition points based on results posted to the WSCC website.
 - 3. Maintain a cumulative data base or spreadsheet of member points.
 - 4. Present updated results for member review at each business meeting.
 - 5. Present cumulated results for year-end awards.
 - 6. Retain points documentation until end of current year.
- B. Club Officers and Committee Chairs must report earned points to the Points Chair within 10 days of each event.
- C. No points challenges on events that occurred more than 10 weeks earlier, or on any events after the January General Meeting of the following year.
- D. The SCC President may appoint an audit committee to verify accrued points if deemed necessary.

II. Corvetter of the Year Award

- A. The Corvetter of the Year is, in the eyes of the membership, the Individuals or Family Members who contributed the most to the betterment of Santa Clara Corvettes.
- B. Nominations for Corvetter of the Year
 - 1. Things to consider when submitting a nomination:
 - a) Someone chairing or working on committees,
 - b) Special projects, stepping up when things need to get done,
 - c) Exhibiting leadership, enthusiasm, and follow-through,
 - d) Hosting events, etc.
 - 2. Each club member may submit one nomination per year.
 - 3. The nominations must be in the form of a written statement (100 words or less) describing what the person has done toward the betterment of Santa Clara Corvettes.

- 4. Nominations must be received by a Board member, either in person or by mail/email prior to November 1st.
- 5. Nominations will be presented to the membership at the November general meeting.

C. Election of Corvetter of the Year

- 1. The Corvetter of the Year nominees will appear on the Election Ballot at the December business meeting.
- 2. Selection is determined by votes cast by club members in accordance with SCC By-laws.
- 3. In case of a tie, duplicate awards will be presented.
- 4. Corvetter of the Year is announced and award presented at the Annual Awards Banquet.

III. Competition Championship Series Awards

- A. The Competition Series may include, but is not limited to: (1) Car Show, Park & Show, Concours, (2) Rallye, (3) Autocross and (4) Drag Race.
- B. Eligible events must be published in the SCC newsletter and/or SCC website Events Calendar at least 15 days prior to the event, or less with Board of Directors approval.
- C. Any SCC Individual or Family Member is eligible to earn a year-end competition award by achieving the following:
 - 1. To receive year-end points in an event, you must have paid your membership dues prior to the time of the event.
 - 2. Qualify by competing in 50% or more of any WSCC Type I or Type II Competition Series (e.g. 50% or more of the WSCC Type I Car Shows held during the year), provided a minimum of three events were scheduled in the series.
 - 3. Drag racing events may include WSCC Type V or "non-WSCC" events.
 - 4. Any member entering more than one car in any event will receive only the points for the car accumulating the highest point total in that event.
 - 5. The member must compete in a Corvette-bodied car with a "Chevrolet based" motor.
 - 6. WSCC Convention competitive events are included.

D. Most Competitive Award

- 1. Individual awards shall be given to both the man and the woman club member accumulating the highest number of Grand Total Competition Championship Series Points.
- 2. In case of a tie, multiple awards will be presented.
- 3. To be eligible for the Most Competitive Award, the member must have qualified in at least two different event series (e.g. Car Show and Autocross).
- 4. Points are awarded according to placement in each of the series events according to the following Point Specifications.
 - a) Car Show, Park & Show, Concours and Autocross:

1 st – 20 points	6 th – 7 points
2 nd – 16 points	7 th – 5 points
3 rd – 13 points	8 th – 3 points
4 th – 11 points	9 th – 2 points
5 th – 9 points	10 th and below – 1 point

b) Drag Racing:

1 st – 20 points	Semi-finals – 12 points			
2 nd – 16 points	Quarter-finals – 6 points			
Below Quarter-finals – 2 points				

c) Rallye:

1 st – 20 points	6 th – 15 points	11 th – 10 points	16 th – 5 points
2 nd – 19 points	7 th – 14 points	12 th – 9 points	17 th – 4 points
3 rd – 18 points	8 th – 13 points	13 th – 8 points	18 th – 3 points

E. Competition Championship Series Point Specifications

1. In order to give each type of series equal value, the sum of the competitive points in each series earned by an individual will be converted to a Weighted Average of the points available.

- 2. To compute the Weighted Average Points:
 - a) Determine the sum of competition points earned by an individual for a series,
 - b) Divide the sum by the total number of points possible for that series,
 - c) Multiply the result by 100.
- 3. To compute the Sum Total Points:
 - a) Total the Weighted Average Points for each series,
 - b) Only the greater of the three Weighted Averages for Car Show, Park & Show and Concours events will be included in the Sum Total.
- 4. To Compute the Grand Total Competition Championship Series Points:
 - a) Competition Championship Series Bonus Points are awarded for Special Awards earned as follows:

Winning WSCC Convention Tri-Challenge	10 points
Winning King or Queen of The Hill at Drag Race	10 points
Winning Auto-x Top Time of Day, Man and Woman	5 points
Winning Sweepstakes or Best of Show	5 points
Winning Best Paint, Interior, Engine, Long Distance, etc.	2 points
Finishing ahead of 5-9 cars in your class	1 point
Finishing ahead of 10 or more cars in your class	2 points

- b) Total Competition Championship Series Bonus Points are added to the Sum Total, resulting in the Grand Total Competition Championship Series Points.
- c) See Scoring Examples in Appendices A and B of this document.

IV. Participation Awards

- A. Participation Awards shall be given to the 25% of the regular members accumulating the highest number of Participation Points as defined below.
- B. In case of a tie, multiple awards will be given.
- C. The number of awards will be based upon the total number of members as of Nov. 15th each year. Fractional numbers are rounded up to the next whole number.

- D. In addition, the Most Participating Award will be given to both the man and the woman club member accumulating the highest number of Participation Points for the year.
- E. To receive year-end Participation Points in a given activity, you must be a regular club member or have completed an application and paid your membership dues for regular club membership prior to the time of the activity.
- F. "Associate" members, spouses or friends (who are not regular members of the club) will not receive year-end Participation Points.
- G. Eligible events must be published in the SCC newsletter and/or SCC website Events Calendar at least 15 days prior to the event, or less with Board of Directors approval.
- H. SCC spectators at events must sign in with SCC event chairperson to be awarded points.
 - 1. Signing in is the responsibility of the individual member, not the event chairperson.
- I. Any associated club activity, such as a committee meeting, will be awarded points whether the meeting is published or not.
 - 1. Appropriate points to be determined by event chairperson.
 - 2. The guideline for workers/committee members is one point per two hours worked, to maximum noted in Appendix C.
 - 3. Points self-awarded by a Board member, beyond the basic one participation point per event, must be approved by the SCC President.

The following is a comparison between members **Bob** (who is more into racing) and **Ed** (who is more into showing) but both are competing for the Most Competitive Award.

Maximum possible points - 6 x 20 = 120

Maximum possible points - 10 x 20 = 200
