4. Laurel Canyon


5. Rodeo Drive

## Collins Orton & Stuart Calhoon: Competition, Motorsports



There are two more SCC autocrosses coming up very soon — Aug 10 - 11 down at Marina Airport. **Rick Bronner** has laid out a nice pair of courses for the weekend, our 6th and 7th events this year, so come on down and join us. (I posted the Saturday course on the SCC Facebook page, and Sunday will be the reverse direction).

We're trying a couple new things this time. First off, we're trying to restrict car numbers so that each driver has a unique number. I (**Stuart**) have been working with SCC and other WSCC folks to get their desired numbers registered into the "official" SCC Autocross Number list. This list is within MotorsportReg, and it should prevent people from registering with a number that's already taken. There are still a couple duplicates, but most of them have been worked out.

Second, we are pushing to get everybody to register ahead of time on MotorsportReg. This makes it much easier on the registration team and the folks doing timing, to know who all is showing up ahead of time, to have all the registration sheets printed out, and to have the information entered into the timing computer. Several other autocross groups have already gone this route, and we're going to join them.

For now, we will still allow same-day registration, but will charge a "late fee." At some point in the future, we plan to eliminate same-day registration.

Third, we are going to run just two run groups on Sunday. We always struggle trying to get enough people into run groups 3 and 4 to have sufficient workers on Sundays, so this will alleviate that problem. What this means is that all Sunday drivers will have to be there, and be registered, by 9 AM. We will close Sunday registration at 9 AM, make sure the two run groups are roughly equal in size, and go for it. This does mean that everybody will have to be there until we're done, but we're always done early on Sundays anyhow. This means everybody will be available to help clean up, and we should still get out of town ahead of the traffic (hopefully).

We appreciate everybody's patience as we incorporate these changes. We believe the autocross experience will be better for everyone once they're all in place.



