

Dave Katz: Competition, Car Shows

Thirty-two SCC members received year-end awards for car show at the **WSCC Awards Banquet** on January 14 in Rancho Cordova. Fifty members received year-end awards for car show at the **SCC Awards Banquet**. Congratulations to all.

Unless WSCC can come up with another Type I car show for 2017 by April 1, there will not be any year-end awards for 2017 car show competition at the 2018 awards banquets. The WSCC Competition Code states that there must be a minimum of three sanctioned events for year-end awards. WSCC only has two Type I events on the calendar for 2017, **Vette-O-Rama** in June and **Corvette Spectacular** in September. Without a third Type I show, Vette-O-Rama and Corvette Spectacular will become Type V shows, and there will not be a car show competition series in 2017. In a Type V car show, cars are not judged in accordance with the WSCC Comp Code. The host club may select any criteria it chooses for presenting awards.

Some of the hopes for a third Type I car show have been dashed. **Corvettes of Bakersfield** is no longer an option. **Rio Vista Corvettes** was unable to secure a car show venue. The SCC Board of Directors will have to evaluate the impact of Corvette Spectacular becoming a Type V car show, such as the effect on attendance and finances.

It seems that car shows may become more of a social event than a competitive event. The intent will be to have fun and hook up with your Corvette buddies. A significant issue is the amount of work involved in hosting a Type I car show. It's easier to host a Type V car show with no formal judging or scoring, no tally room, possibly fewer awards, no complaints, no competition code and no protests.

The first Type V show of the season is the **Just for Corvettes** car show at **Hooters** in Sacramento on April 1. There are local car shows that are not affiliated with WSCC. We can still make them club events. You will receive a participation point for caravanning to and for attending a car show that has been designated as an SCC club event.

I am hoping for a successful car show season, with the focus on having fun instead of on competition. If the third Type I show pops up, we can go back into full competition mode. It is still possible that there will be at least three Type I shows in 2018, especially if the transition from Type I to Type V doesn't go well.

Detail Addict, a detail shop in Santa Clara, would like to put on a free detailing clinic for our club on Sunday, March 19. I will be taking sign-ups at the February meeting. They need a minimum of 15 attendees to make the event worth their effort.

Handheld Communication Devices - What's Legal?

AB-1785 has become the new law (Section 23123.5 of the Vehicle Code). It is intended to replace and clarify the previous law, but seems to only create new questions. My non-legal interpretation is that all wireless handheld devices are illegal to use while driving. Exceptions appear to include devices that are appropriately mounted to the windshield or center console AND require only a single tap or swipe to operate - much like a factory installed GPS system or a hard-wired CB radio.

So, how does that affect the handheld FRS radios used by so many caravanning Corvetters? Sounds like they could now land you an infraction and a fine. Perhaps one could make a case for a mounted FRS radio, but the act of using your whole hand to squeeze the TALK button probably exceeds the "single tap or swipe" definition. Hands-free, voice-activated appears to be the only *clearly* legal option. Additional incentive to carry a passenger!
