3. The club started with a handful of enthusiasts meeting in a parking lot in 1975 and today in 2019 has 189 members.



# SANTA CLARA CORVETTES LOGO HISTORY 1975

As I recall, back in 1973 we moved to Bonita Street, Mt. View, a few blocks from Cuesta Park. I had sold my 1968 Corvette in May just before getting married. In late afternoons and Saturday mornings Corvettes would pass by while I was working on my 1958 Willys pickup that I dropped in a Chevy small block V8. I was focused on getting my truck complete so I could drive it.

One afternoon in 1974 a Corvette pulled up and Tom Saunders stepped out to introduce himself. He lived 3 or 4 houses down the street. We exchanged the usual questions “what do you do for a living, where do you work? etc...” Then we began talking about previously owned cars. I told him about my 2 Corvettes and he told me about his. He told me about what he had done to his 1969 big block coupe; how it had a new high rise intake and bigger carburetor, headers, distributor, added chrome under the new high rise hood and flared fenders to accommodate the wide wheels and tires. It looked fast while parked, because it was. When he was leaving he said several corvette enthusiasts meet at Cuesta Park Saturday mornings in the parking lot near the handball court and invited me to stop by. “I am thinking about starting a car club.”

Over the next few months I hung out with the group, talked about all the models and options, pros and cons with each year and I was soaking up the intel on all models. Most of them had C3s big blocks, several C2s and a couple of C1s.

I didn't have a corvette yet but Tom asked me to read and edit the SCC constitution because of my background. There was a lot of disagreement on wording and membership requirements so he wanted an outside persons opinion. I went to Tom's house for a meeting, gave my opinions and left my notes with Tom.

Months later **Teri** and I bought a Corvette Bronze 1970 small block coupe with every factory option that year.

As time past Tom had a vision on what Mt. View Corvettes was to be and everything he had planned and worked for became a real club. With real rules, real friendships, real community service and really fun. But the name did not fit. Tom wanted to be county wide and Santa Clara County Corvette Club was a better name for what Tom envisioned to grow



into. Because the name did not fit onto letterhead it was shortened to Santa Clara Corvettes.

The logo committee at the time wanted to have something unique that stands out from other clubs and stand the test of time. The newly founded Santa Clara Corvettes club had to create a logo that would stand out from other clubs.

Tom Saunders was passionate about corvettes, people enjoying themselves at events, BBQs, Club parties, auto-crosses, club sports events, and community. The Logo committee had multiple submissions but the current logo was voted for unanimously on October 1, 1975.

When I see our SCC logo it reminds me of looking in my rearview mirror and seeing our founder of SCC Tom Saunders driving over a hill in Napa at sunrise.

Without our founder Tom Saunders there would be no Santa Clara Corvettes today.

Santa Clara Corvette logo is known throughout cities and state in California, Oregon, Washington, Nevada, Arizona, Utah and Colorado. But it is also known in the mid-west and on East coast and Europe. Our sponsors are proud to display the SCC Logo at their business.

Thank you Tom Saunders for everything you did for us. And thank all those who gave it their all in the beginning. And thank all those boards and club members who have made Santa Clara Corvettes a fun place to belong.




